

Lightroom Export Presets (Example shown is for a DPI Club Competition)

1. In Lightroom go to File menu>Export

2. Complete the settings as shown on the right.

3. Select 'Add' button as highlighted.

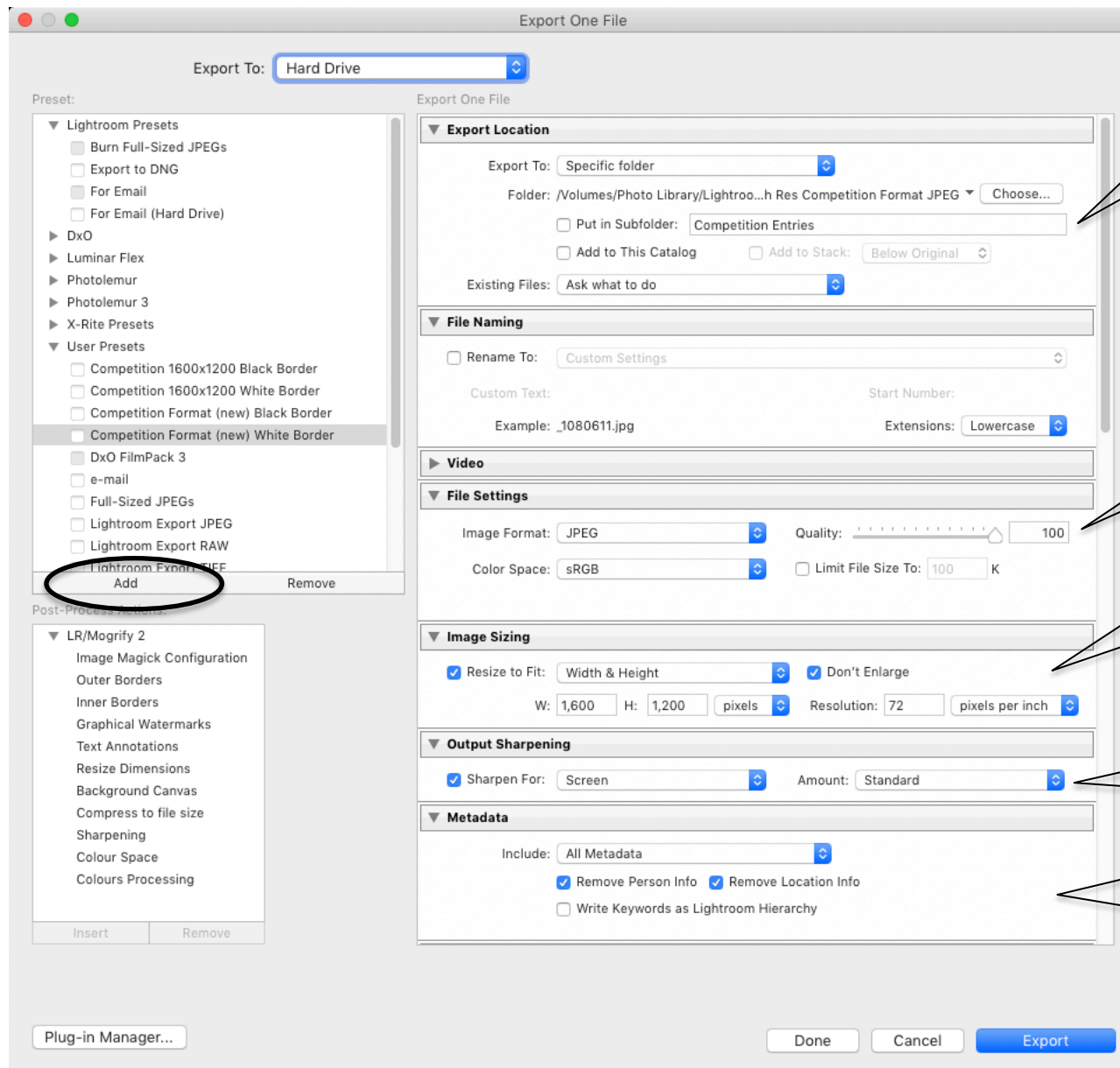
4. In the dialogue box give the preset a name and save it, e.g 'PAGB Competition Format'

5. To use the preset simply select the image you want to export in either the Library or Develop module by right clicking your mouse, and choose Export. Pick your named user preset from the menu shown.

6. Your exported file will be found in the folder you chose as the Export Location.

Also highly recommended is the Lightroom Plugin 'Mogrify' which allows borders, watermarks and much more to be added automatically to your exported images. This can be found at;

Select/create a folder for your exported file to go into eg 'Lightroom Exports'

Copy the file settings as shown. This sets the correct format, colour space and limits the file size.

Copy the image size settings as shown for club DPI competition entries,

These are the settings for projected images.

Choose what metadata you want attached to your file, e.g. camera settings, date taken etc.
